International Undergraduate Program in the Department of Business Administration (IUP in BA)

Application Guidelines For TaiwanICDF Scholarship Applicants ONLY

Scope of Curriculum

1. Credits for Graduation: 128 Credits, including Chinese Language Courses (24 Credits) and General Courses (4-8 Credits), Required Courses (54 Credits) and Elective Courses (42-46 Credits).
2. Students are required to pass Level 2 of the Test of Chinese as Foreign Language (TOCFL), failing to acquire a TOCFL certificate of the required level must take and pass 4 semesters of NCCU Mandarin Special Courses (one course per semester) at their own expense before graduation in order to meet this requirement .
3. The IUP in BA provides most courses in English and various professional courses and focuses on relevant management courses.
4. Students will receive a “Bachelor of Business Administration” Degree from the Department of Business Administration at the College of Commerce after completing their studies.
5. If the course program or graduation regulations are subject to change in the future, students will be required to follow any such new rules.

Qualification

1. Applicants must be citizens of a qualified partner country. Please check the TaiwanICDF website (<http://www.icdf.org.tw/ct.asp?xItem=12506&CtNode=30317&mp=2>) or contact the Taiwan embassy or Representative office to see if you are eligible.
2. A Senior High School Degree.
3. Fluent English skills and a TOEFL score or other evidence of English proficiency for applicants whose native language is NOT English

A. NCCU Application Procedure & Materials

NCCU Application Deadline : 15th March, 2019 (by post) 5PM, 22th March, 2019 (in person)

Documents Required: All application documents should be provided in English and properly bound into four separate copies in consecutive order

1. NCCU Application CheckList, 2 completed NCCU Online Application Form with a recent photo attached to each, Mailing Address Label, Declaration.
 - **All above documents are generated by the NCCU online application system**
 - **TaiwanICDF scholarship applicants MUST choose “degree” student in the “Status Applied.”**
2. Copy of a valid Passport
3. One Copy of Diploma and One Original Official Transcript verified by the ROC (Taiwan) Embassy / Consulate General / Representative Office
 - Current graduates are required to submit an official certificate of expected graduation (English or Chinese) issued by the school in lieu of the diploma at the time of application

- One notarized copy of the translation in English or Chinese is necessary if the original diploma or transcript are NOT in English or in Chinese
- 4. Study Plan in Chinese or English
- 5. Evidence of English Proficiency (for non-English-speaking countries)
- 6. Resume
- 7. Autobiography and other Supporting Materials
- 8. 2 letters of Recommendation

Please submit all NCCU Admission Application Materials stated above directly to the Department of Business Administration, College of Commerce, National Chengchi University.

- TaiwanICDF scholarship applicants are **free of application fee**
